This beautiful quilt, inspired by the popular Christmas Carol, is so much fun to make and will look fabulous on your wall for your festive decorations

Requirements List

- Background Fabric 23" x 18"
 Plus a piece measuring 18" x 4" for foreground
- I have used 9 x pieces of fabric for buildings. I bought 9 fat ¼ (surplus can be used on other projects).
- Small pieces of fabrics for the palm trees (these could come from your scrap box)
- Gold fabric for windows (or fabric of your choice)
- Heat & Bond or whatever you like to use at least ½ metre.
- Wadding or felt 23" x 18"
- Backing fabric 23" x 18"
- Thread of your choice for cording (I used metallic perle cotton)
- Thread for sewing cording (This will be used in the sewing machine to attach the thicker thread).
 Metallic threads looks good, this will also be used for blanket stitch around the buildings.
- Metallic fabric of your choice for the star 8" x 7"
- Sharpe point scissors.
- Sewing machine
- Open toe foot or cording foot.
- Pencil.
- Travel iron and ironing pad or folded towel.
